4. Verse 31 says it is a dreadful thing to fall into the hands of the living God. What do you think this means?

Hebrews 10:32-39

1. The author of Hebrews appeals to the reader's initial faith. What has changed for you from the time you first believed until now?

2. Verse 35 implores us not to "throw away your confidence, that it will be richly rewarded." What do you think that means?

3. What does verse 39 mean to you?
