Mark 8:34-38 1. What is the main point in this passage?
2. Who does Jesus address here?
3. Verse 36 poses a question. What do you think the answer to that question is?
4. Verse 37 also poses a question. What do you think the answer to it is?
5. What do you think is the point of Jesus challenging and asking questions like this?
